Scripture

Exodus 3:7-10 (NIV®)

⁷ The LORD said, "I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. ⁸ So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land, a land flowing with milk and honey—the home of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. ⁹ And now the cry of the Israelites has reached me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them. ¹⁰ So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt."

Discussion Questions

- 1. What is the difference between knowing Jesus and Jesus being Lord of your life?
- 2. Describe a time when you said "yes" to the Lord without a clear picture/idea of what would happen next. What was the outcome?
- 3. Share about a time when God interrupted your routine or altered your life plan. What was the outcome?
- 4. What are some things you do to draw close to God and seek His wisdom?
- 5. In what areas of your life have you tended to avoid difficult situations or conversations about your faith? How can you intentionally be more courageous in those situations?
